GRK 2025 Reaches Its Peak

Yamazumi Dominates Solo, Shimada Reigns in Exhibition Battle

The culmination of the 2025 season, the “GRK Ultimate Championship,” was held over two days on December 20th and 21st at Hobby Shop TamTam Nagoya. Challenging this main event, which adopted judging criteria and course layouts following the D1GP format, were 129 elite drivers who had won through qualifying rounds held at eight venues nationwide. On a stage worthy of being called the “RC version of D1GP,” all the skills honed thus far were put to the ultimate test.

In the single-run qualifying, Shinichi Yamazumi demonstrated overwhelming dominance. He consistently scored near-perfect marks, achieving a Best Score of 98.9 points and a 2nd Score of 97.55 points. His driving, combining stability and sharp precision, secured him the undisputed top spot. Then came the final of the pursuit tournament. Defending champion Takumi Shimada and solo qualifying winner Shinichi Yamazumi clashed for the championship.



A fierce battle ensued with neither driver yielding an inch. Ultimately, Shimada gained the upper hand, securing a magnificent second consecutive victory. He reclaimed the title of GRK's strongest driver. It was a memorable championship showdown, a fitting conclusion to the 2025 GRK season.
